Hours of Service for Entrance and Clearance

Inspection services for the entrance/arrival of aircraft at Boston Logan International Airport are available 7 days per week, 24 hours per day in accordance with the port's permission to land procedures.

Commercial aircraft operators departing the U.S. must obtain an outbound clearance by contacting CBP directly.

Permission to Land Procedures

Pilots must secure permission to land by contacting CBP prior to departure from the foreign port or place and at least 24 hours in advance of the anticipated arrival time at KBOS.

Permission to land is granted with a tolerance of (+/-) 30 minutes. If your ETA deviates outside these parameters, previously granted permission(s) are invalid and you must contact the CBP port to re-secure permission to land.

Inspection Process

- Aircraft will park at Signature FBO ramp.
- CBP Officers will meet the aircraft on the ramp at the FBO.
- Passengers and crew will be processed on the aircraft.
- For those that are unable to be processed on the aircraft, Signature will escort them to the FIS and return them to aircraft when processing is complete.
- Passengers and crew should be prepared to present valid entry documents.
- Crew should also be prepared to present pilots license, medical certificate and user fee decal (if appropriate).
- Regulated waste will be handled by Signature.

Special Procedures/Miscellaneous

- KBED, KMHT and KPSM are within Boston Logan's (KBOS) AOR. Questions regarding those airports should be directed to those POE's during their business hours. For questions after hours, contact Logan Airport at 617-568-1810 ext. 0.
